*This is the minimum requirement for entry to the profession. Pharmacists may also choose to maintain a full first aid certificate depending on their personal circumstances and needs.*

**First Aid Certificate Refresher** \$100 per person (incl GST)

NZQA Unit Standards: **6400, 6401, 6402**

Workshop Course takes 7 hours over 1 day

*For those choosing to maintain their **full** first aid certificate, which requires completion of a refresher course every 2 years.*

**Pharmacists CPR-Only Course** \$50 per person (incl GST)

NZQA Unit Standard: **6402**

Workshop Course takes 3 hours

*This is the minimum requirement for maintaining evidence of competency in Competence Standard 3. Pharmacy Council requirements state that pharmacists must update their CPR skills once every three years. Covers CPR training and a general first aid scenario session.*
