Instructions to compound suspension: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. AREA CLEARED FOR PROCESSING BY : 2. If Ora-Blend SF unavailable: Pre-mix the Ora-Plus and Ora-Sweet SF, to form the diluent. 3. Add capsule contents to a mortar and add diluent (Ora-Blend SF[®] or prepared diluent) to form a smooth paste. 4. Gradually add diluent and transfer to final measuring flask, rinsing mortar well. Mix well. 5. Make up to final volume and mix well. 6. Transfer finished product to pre-rinsed amber plastic medicine bottle and use KlikLok closure if available. Shake well to ensure complete dispersion of capsule contents. 7. Label appropriately. Additional labels: Shake the bottle. Store at room temperature.
